Form VTG1 must be used when applying for a test for:

- · a heavy goods vehicle when a Ministry Plate has not previously been issued
- a vehicle previously exempt from testing (eg fire engine, access platform)
- · an ex-ministry of Defence vehicle
- · an imported vehicle over one year old

A separate application form must be completed for both vehicle and trailer in a combination. Trailer applications should be submitted on form VTG2 for first test or form VTG40 for annual test.

If the vehicle is imported from another EC country (excluding Greece and Eire) please also apply to the Vehicle Certification Agency for a British type approval certificate under the provisions of EC Commission Notice (88/C281/08):
